23g Plan – MI Kids Back on Track Grant Coopersville Area Public Schools Oct. 2023

What is 23g?

These funds are designated to support students before, during and after school to address unfinished learning. These funds are targeted toward students who may fall behind their peers in grade level standards.

Implementation of funds:

CAPS will provide identified students evidence based instructional practices in tier 2 and 3 supports. A goal is to provide training on essential standards and a guaranteed and viable curriculum to all students. However, when necessary and identified by appropriate screening students will be given additional instructional support with teaching staff and or paraprofessional.

CAPS will use 23g funds to support where identified the need of tier 2 and 3 academic and behavior coaching for staff. As such the grant may fund coaches for instructional purposes on essential standards and modeling effective teaching/behavior practices. Also, this specialized staff needed to support students in gaining additional instructional strategies for support in both behavior and academic measures.

CAPS will use consistent data set to identify all students behind in academic and or behavior achievement and growth. This may also require support staff to prepare accurate reporting, tracking, progress monitoring reports.

CAPS 23g Reporting measures

Program measures are based on NWEA, local assessment, M-STEP, and other diagnostic measures used in reading and math. Monitoring will consist of District and school reports. CAPS will comply with all reporting requirements, both state and federal.
